Subject Network Package: 3 x F2F subject networks, access to research, insights and conception of quality	We have networks for every area of the curriculum. In each network our subject leads think deeply about ‘what makes for quality’. They are supported to build a bank of evidence that demonstrates the impact of their local subject curriculum. Networks typically run in the afternoons.	£250 per annum
Provision area networks (SEND and EY): 3 x F2F subject networks, access to research, insights and conception of quality	Our provision networks include insights into the latest SEND and EY research. Each network has its own ‘mini’ curriculum and conception of quality. Delegates have access to our handbooks and highly developed systems and processes. Our SEND review is a comprehensive audit led by a system leader whose special setting has achieved ‘outstanding’ Ofsted ratings in three consecutive inspections.
